
QUICK FACTS

- 1. NIGERIA LOSES AN ESTIMATED Nº95 BILLION ANNUALLY TO CRUDE OIL THEFT
- 2. NIGERIA IS RANKED THE WORST COUNTRY WORLDWIDE IN TERMS OF CRUDE OIL THEFT

IN THE LAST 4 YEARS, NIGERIA HAS LOST APPROXIMATELY 43% OF RECORDED REVENUE TO OIL THEFT. WHICH AMOUNTS TO 17% OF THE COUNTRY'S BUDGET FOR SAME PERIOD. THE AMOUNT LOST COULD HAVE PAID 28.7% OF NIGERIA'S BUDGET DEFICIT IN THAT PERIOD



N1.6 TN LOSS TO OIL THEFT IS 61% OF NIGERIA'S REVENUE (N2.62 TN). AND CAN OFFSET 47% OF 2016'S DEFICIT



N995 BN LOSS TO OIL THEFT IS 37% OF NIGERIA'S REVENUE (N2.66 TN). AND CAN OFFSET 22% OF 2017'S DEFICIT



N995 BN LOSS TO OIL THEFT IS OF NIGERIA'S REVENUE (N3.5 TN). AND CAN OFFSET OF 2018'S DEFICIT

THE TOTAL CAPITAL EXPENDITURE THE TOTAL CAPITAL EXPENDITURE THE TOTAL CAPITAL EXPENDITURE (N435 BN) ON POWER, WORKS & HOUSING 2017 IS 44% OF CRUDE OIL THEFT LOSS



EDUCATION

THE TOTAL CAPITAL EXPENDITURE (N61.7 BN) ON EDUCATION 2017 IS ONLY 6% OF CRUDE OIL THEFT LOSS

COMBINED CAPITAL EXPENDITURE ON THESE SECTORS IN 2017 (N831.5 BN) IS LOWER THAN THE AVERAGE YEARLY LOSS TO CRUDE OIL THEFT BY 15%.
